Revolutionary War Minuteman 1775-1783

The Pensacola Chapter, Florida Society, National Society Sons of the American Revolution (SAR) and the Pensacola Chapter, Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR) with the approval and cooperation of the Pensacola Veterans Memorial Foundation are going to erect a statue to honor the patriots and soldiers of the Revolutionary War. The Minuteman, is a time honored symbol of those who sacrificed their lives and fortunes in support of the Revolutionary war.

The Minuteman Statue will be an eternal tribute and reminder to all of our ancestors that through their many sacrifices gave us our freedoms as we know them today. This memorial will be a significant addition to the existing veteran memorials already found downtown at the Pensacola Veterans Memorial and will be a valuable asset to Pensacola's diverse historical tourism attractions.

The Pensacola Chapter SAR and Pensacola Chapter DAR are both historical, educational, and patriotic, non-profit 501(c)3 corporations, dedicated

to maintaining and expanding the meaning of patriotism, respect for our national symbols, and the value of American citizenship through awareness and continued education. Contributions are tax deductible and contributors will receive a written acknowledgement for their contribution.

Surrounding the Minuteman statue base will be a paver walkway consisting of memorial pavers for individual contributors of \$100 or greater. The memorial paver inscriptions are limited to 3 lines containing up to 20 characters for each line including blank spaces. It is suggested that an ideal inscription might be engraved with the contributor's revolutionary war patriot ancestor's name and the patriotic service of that ancestor. The following is an example of a typical memorial paver as suggested:

**Pvt. Valentine
Bergstresser
Bucks Co. PA Militia**

Major contributors will be provided recognition at the memorial site commensurate to their support. Recognition method and site location will be determined by the Revolutionary War Memorial Committee at the time of the commencement of memorial construction. If desired a major contributor may opt for an memorial paver as described above in lieu of the marker and must be indicated at the time their contribution is received.

The memorial site will be between the existing Wall South and WW I memorials shown as an "X" in the Veterans Memorial Park photo on page 1.
