Each year a portion (around \$13,000 the past couple years) is allotted to reimburse chapters for awards to non-SAR members. Basically it reimburses you for 100% of the cost of medals and 75% for many other approved activities.** This session is to review how to fill out the request form, to cover what is presently reimbursable and seek suggestions on what other items/activities should be authorized.
- **why anyone should consider attending that session.** -These activities are good recruiting tools and definitely help your chapter budget to expand in these areas. The deadline is Nov. 15.

## READ - - - - Attention to BOM voters

Voting delegate categories are: Patriot Medal, FLSSAR Officer, FLSSAR Committee chair, Past FLSSAR President, Incumbent/past National Officer, FLSSAR National Trustee, Chapter President, Immediate Past Chapter President, Chapter Delegate.

Given in descending order of preference -

- If you are a Patriot Medal holder, you do NOT have to select that option - it is automatically listed for you.
- If you are a State National Trustee, you do NOT have to select that option - it is automatically listed for you.
- If you are a State Officer, you do NOT have to select that option - it is automatically listed for you.
- If you are a State Committee Chair, you do NOT have to select that option - it is automatically listed for you.
- If you are a Former State President, you do NOT have to select that option - it is automatically listed for you.
- If you are a Chapter President or the IMMEDIATE Past President, you do NOT have to select that option - it is automatically listed for you if your chapter has submitted the current officer roster. If any of the previous categories apply to you they will be given preference to your chapter office.
- **To be designated as a Chapter Delegate, that designation MUST BE SUBMITTED by the chapter to the state secretary BEFORE the BOM.**
