Good Citizenship program

The Elementary and Middle School Good Citizenship program is one that is very easy for chapters to participate in.

- 1. Chapters should contact their respective school District offices and talk to either the Superintendent of Education or the Curriculum and explain that one certificate is available for every fifth grade in the Elementary schools and every sixth grade in the Middle Schools.
- 2. The individual classroom teacher determines what student they wish to honor as a "Good Citizen."
- 3. Certificates may be obtained from FLSSAR Secretary. The chapter President and Secretary signs all the certificates that will be handed out and includes the chapter name on the certificate. This can be done either by computer, having a print shop do the job at a cost to the chapter, or by individually signing each one and putting the chapter name in the proper space.
- 4. When the school system has determined how many classrooms will be using the program, the chapter notifies our Society Secretary as to the number of blank certificates they will need.
- 5. The Society Secretary will then arrange to have that number of certificates at the next BOM for the chapter to pick up and begin their preparation of the certificates prior to their delivering them to the local School District office.
- 6. The School District office delivers them to their Elementary and Middle Schools where the principal will see that each 5th and 6th grade teacher has one certificate to fill in the date and the name of the student being honored.

This should be sufficient information for any chapter who wishes to participate in this program to be effective in the administration of the program.
