## Silver ROTC Medal

**BEFORE** starting on your SAR Silver ROTC Medal Form below, please follow the “Save” instructions.

Use the “Save to Your PC” button. Add the Cadet’s Name to the Saved file Name.

For example, “**Cadet SGT George Compatriot Silver ROTC Medal.PDF**”.

Now **CLOSE** the web page and **OPEN** the saved File on your PC to Continue.

*When you place your mouse over most of the “text” data entry fields below, a feature called a “tooltip” will display as a window/popup to give you additional instructions concerning what should be entered in that field.*

**“Tooltips” provide important instructions – Please read them carefully.**

The SAR Silver ROTC Medal is approved by the United States Army, the United States Navy, the United States Marine Corps, and the United States Air Force. Each service has notified its ROTC Units of this approval and has authorized presentation to its cadets.

This award may be presented by the National Society, a state society or a chapter to students enrolled in ROTC programs. The medal endeavors to foster the principle of “citizen-soldier” exemplified by the Minutemen.

Recipients are selected for a high degree of merit with respect to leadership qualities, military bearing and general excellence. The recipients are selected by the Commanding Officer of the ROTC unit, who should be given full latitude in making the selection.

One medal will normally be awarded each year in ROTC units with fewer than 500 cadets or midshipmen. For larger units, one medal may be presented for each 500 students enrolled in the unit. Moreover, where a school has more than one ROTC unit, each unit is counted separately. It is desirable to have the medal on display with its ribbon bar in a trophy case at each school where it is presented. This will serve as an incentive to the students and publicize the SAR ROTC program as well.

The Silver ROTC Medal is presented only to students in a university ROTC unit. No recipient may receive it more than once.
